The criteria to obtain a grant are as follows:

- A woman-owned Business or Women's Organization
- Women's Roundtable members and their relatives are welcome to apply but they will not receive special consideration.
- Start-up business or a business in existence not more than five years.
- Completed Grant Application
- Must show support for women through activities and involvement with organizations that benefit women.
- A written report will be required of Grantee within three months of receipt to verify how the funds were used.
- Should the Grantee not comply with the terms of the grant, WRT has the right to request a refund of the specified funds within a reasonable time period.
- Prior Grantees are ineligible.
